1. The original Home Fund was established in:
1945 or 1936
2. The current member contribution is ____% of dues:

3. Among gifts to the fund was a gift of \$10,000 in honor of:
Mary Patton or Laura G. Smith
4. From 1958 through 1974, there was an assessment of each PEO member in Minnesota to provide funds for the Home Fund of:

5. As a “P.E.O. Home” became unfeasible, the Home Fund became “The Minnesota P.E.O. Home Fund”, a non-profit organization. This was accomplished in:
1973 or 1974
6. With the establishment of the corporation, a program was begun, called:
North Star Grant program or North Star P.E.O. Grant Program
7. The Northstar Program provides assistance to:
P.E.O.s who are poor. or Persons who are indigent, aged or infirm .
8. Mary B. Patton provided money to the Home Fund through:
a loan or her will.
9. The concept instituted in 1985 provided for:
a home within a home or permanent grants of \$1000.00
10. At one time, housing was provided in:
*Jones Harrison Home or Watkins Home or Gideon Pond Retirement Home
